What Are Clutch Noises Telling You? - Phoenix Friction Do this by leaving the clutch engaged by not compressing the clutch pedal. If you hear a growl or grind, the transmission input shaft has a bad bearing. Make sure you apply a small amount of grease as required to the ball stud If the noise gets louder when you push the pedal further in, the clutch release bearing is bad
